

Introducing: MV Pelee Islander II

She is here! MV Pelee Islander II is expected to arrive at the Kingsville dock on Friday morning, June 15, 2018.

But before she lands, we are very pleased to provide an advance look at the new MV Pelee Islander II as she makes her way through the St. Lawrence Seaway, the Great Lakes Ontario and Erie, and finally to her new home – the Pelee Island Ferry Service.

Here is a little bit about the vessel:

Vessel Description – Roll-on/Roll-off Passenger Ferry

Overall Length – 67.7 metres

Breath – 14.8 metres

Month/Year Built – April 2018

Passenger Capacity – 399

Vehicle Capacity – 34 cars (with no tractor trailers) or 4 tractor trailers and 16 cars

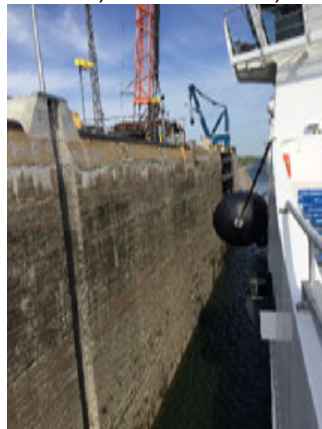
Boat Deck - Total combined seating capacity for 180 passengers on this deck. Passenger seating on this deck is located forward, mid-ship and aft and also includes a covered pet area.

Upper Deck – Forward lounge has seating capacity for 182 passengers. A cafeteria is also located on this deck that will offer a menu similar to that of the MV Jiimaan. The cafeteria has seating capacity for 60 passengers.

MV Pelee Islander II's first stop in Canada was in Montreal where the vessel underwent customs clearance, a Seaway Inspection, and had her external fenders mounted. The heavy rubber fenders will protect the vessel from damage while transiting the many locks in the Seaway system. The fenders will remain on the vessel until she arrives in Kingsville.

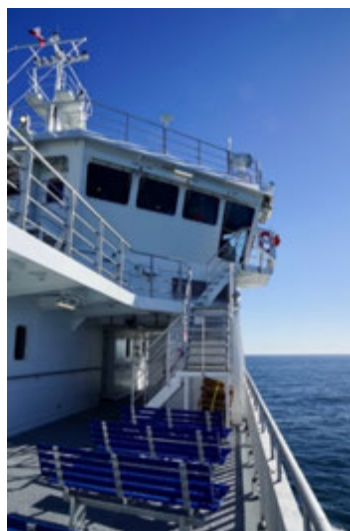
Fenders in use during Seaway Lock transits June 12, 2018.

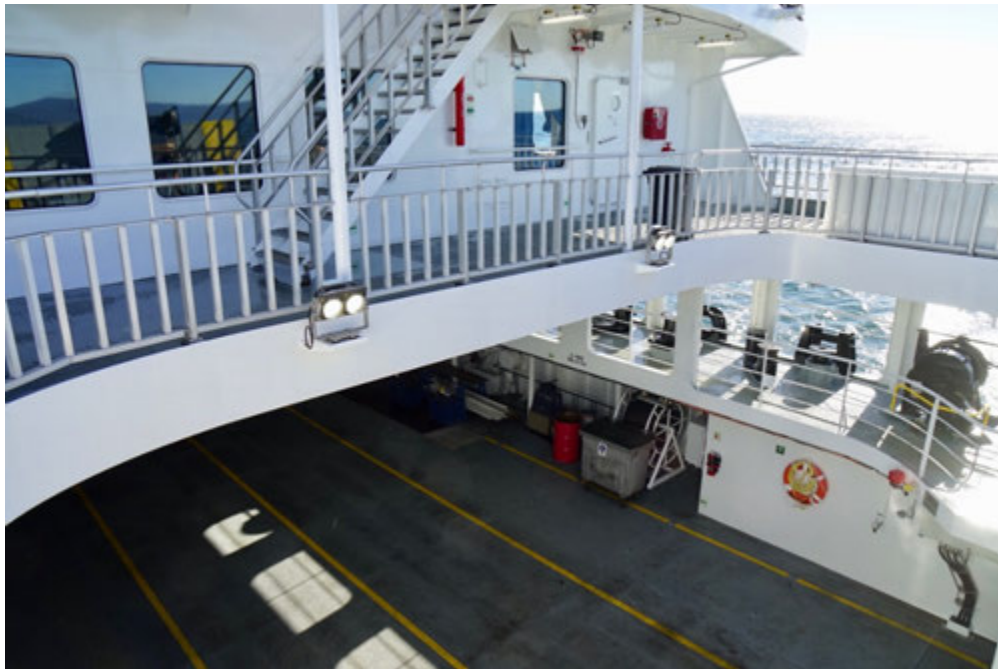
