



## Covid-19: Exemption from Vaccination

In accordance with Transport Canada regulations, Cameron Air Service requires that ALL passengers be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 in order to board their aircraft. Passengers who are not fully vaccinated will be denied boarding unless a legitimate religious or medical exemption has been granted.

Passengers seeking to obtain a religious or medical exemption are required to contact Cameron Air Service directly in order to request an exemption form. Completing these forms by no means guarantees an individual exempt status and is subject to review by Cameron Air and our legal representatives.

Any individual who is seeking exempt status, but has not yet been granted it, will NOT be allowed to board any Cameron Air flights until the exemption has been reviewed and accepted.

Travelers that cannot be vaccinated for religious or medical reasons will be required to present a **NEGATIVE COVID-19 MOLECULAR TEST** that has been performed no more than **72hrs** prior to their departure time. Passengers with an exemption who **DO NOT** have a valid test will be denied boarding.

Vaccination against Covid-19 is the best way to keep you and your neighbors safe. Please consider others before applying for an exemption.
