## Proof of Covid-19 vaccination requirements for Pelee Winter Air Service passengers

In accordance with Transport Canada's *Interim Order Respecting Certain Requirements for Civil Aviation Due to Covid-19* passengers on the Pelee Island Winter Air Service will be required to show proof of Covid-19 vaccination prior to boarding flights as described herein.

### **Flights Departing Windsor – proof of vaccination required:**

All passengers over 12 years plus 4 months of age are required to show proof of Covid-19 vaccination or an approved exemption before boarding the aircraft. Passengers granted an exemption will need to have a valid COVID-19 molecular test taken no more than 72 hours before boarding the flight from Windsor to Pelee Island.

### **Flights Departing Pelee Island – NO proof of vaccination required:**

Passengers may leave Pelee Island without showing proof of vaccination but will not be able to return to Pelee by air on the Pelee Winter Air Service without showing proof of vaccination on departure from Windsor.

Passengers traveling from Pelee Island to Windsor are encouraged to voluntarily show proof of Covid-19 vaccination on first departure from Pelee Island to expedite future travel. Passengers whose proof of vaccination has been confirmed will not be required to show it again on subsequent flights unless the definition of full vaccination is changed by PHAC or Transport Canada.

**Definition of fully vaccinated:** To qualify as a fully vaccinated traveller, you must have received at least 2 doses of an accepted vaccine or a mix of 2 accepted vaccines, or at least 1 dose of the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson vaccine, at least 14 full days prior to the day you travel (date of flight).
